

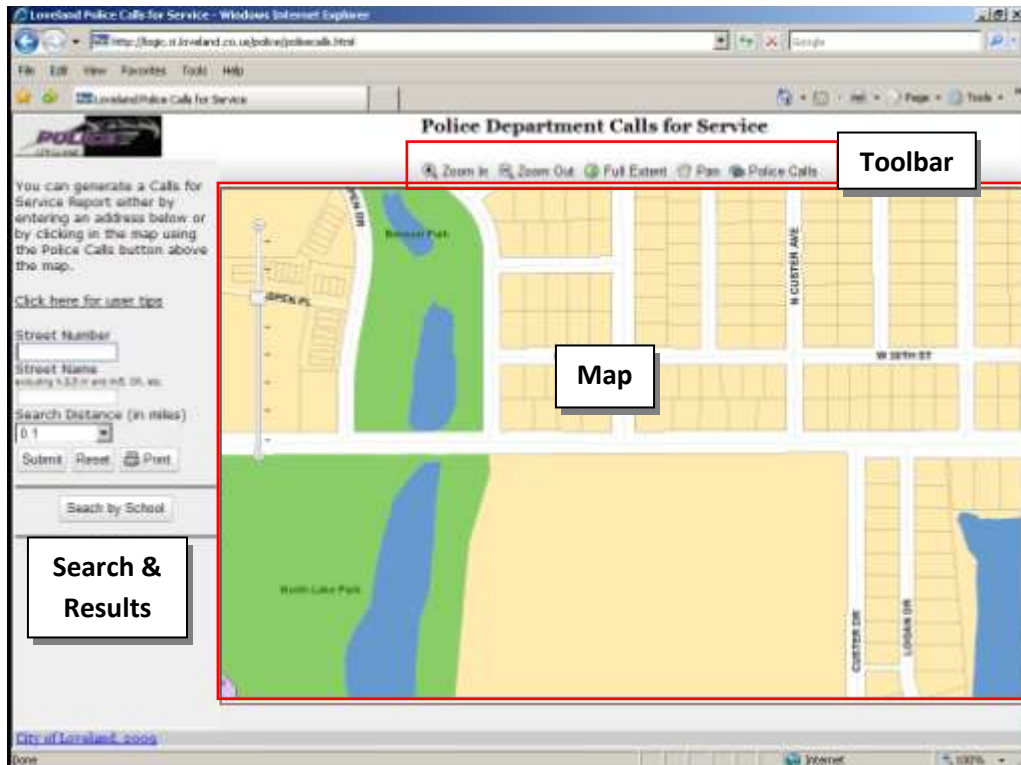


Loveland Police Department - online Calls for Service

The Calls of Service web site can be used to generate a map and a report for calls received and entered into the Department's CAD during the past 52 weeks. The map and report can be generated by an address, a school, or by clicking in the map. The web site has three main parts:

- **The Map** - the main part of the page is the map display. You can navigate around the map using the Zoom and Pan controls above the map or with the slider in the upper left of the map. You can also zoom in/out by rolling the wheel on your mouse, if it has one.



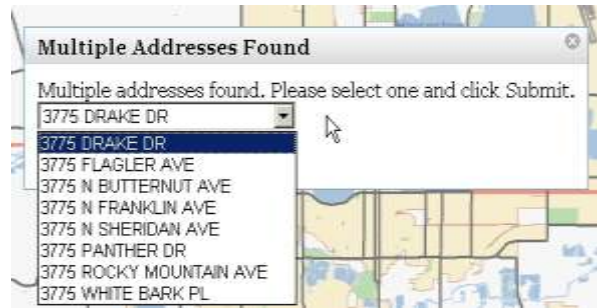
- **Search & Results Panel** - the left side of the page allows you to search the Calls for Service around an address or a school in Loveland. The default distance to search around a location is 0.1 miles, but this can be changed to 0.25 miles. The search distance selected in the Search Panel is used by all methods of searching – by Address, School, or clicking in the map. Using the larger search area will slow down the searching, especially near busy intersections.



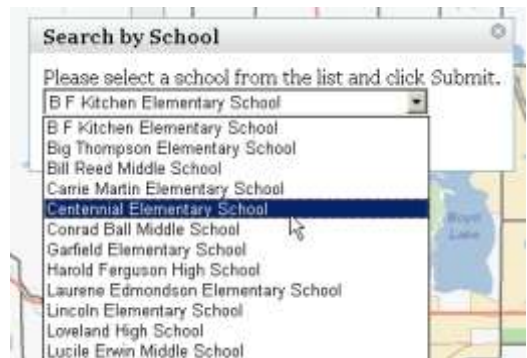

- **Search by Address** – Use the Street Number and/or Street Name boxes to look up known addresses. You can enter an address number, a street name or a combination of both. Entering an address number and clicking the Submit button will generate a pick list of all addresses starting with that number and is the easiest way to search. You can also enter just the street name and get a list of all addresses on that street.



- **Search by School** – Clicking on the ‘Search by School’ button will display a pick list of all Thompson School District schools in Loveland. Select the school of interest and click OK to search for calls around the school.



After an address or school has been selected and the Calls mapped, a summary of the number of Calls received will be displayed at the bottom of the Search & Results panel under the ‘Results’ heading. You can then print out the map and the summary by clicking the Print button. This will redraw the map and the call summary in a new window, sized to fit on a printed page.

To start a new search click the ‘Reset’ button below the Street Name box. This will clear the Results panel and remove the previously mapped Calls from the map. Clicking the Reset button will also speed up navigating around the map, especially if the previous results generated a large number of Calls in the search area.

- **Toolbar.** The toolbar contains a series of buttons that allow you to navigate around the map. It also contains the ‘Police Calls’ button which allows you to map Calls & generate the report by clicking anywhere in the map.








When using the toolbar, only one tool can be active at a time. The active tool will have a

blue background and highlight to denote which one is active. The exception to this is the Full Extent button, which immediately zooms the map out to show the full city limits of Loveland. In the example toolbar above, the Pan tool is currently active. The table below explains what each tool does.

Name	Icon	Description
Zoom In		Click and draw a box in the map to zoom in. Click and hold the left mouse button to draw the box. When you release the box, the map will zoom in to that area.
Zoom Out		Click and draw a box in the map to zoom out. Click and hold the left mouse button to draw the box – the smaller the box, the farther out you will zoom. The map will zoom out when you release the mouse button.
Full extent		Full extent: Immediately zoom the map out to the full extent of Loveland. The active tool does not change.
Pan (re-center)		Click and drag the map: Click and hold the left mouse button on the map, and drag the map. The map will be re-centered, with the location dragged at the location you dropped it.
Police Calls		Click the tool and then click in the map. When you click in the map it will generate the map and report for all Calls within the search area of where you clicked. You can click anywhere in the map – on a street intersection, a parcel, a park, etc... Note that since the Calls are always mapped to the street centerlines, clicking in a location away from any streets may result in few or no Calls being mapped.
